When we go to God together in prayer, we need to remember that there is power in prayer because God hears us when we pray. James 5:16-18 tells us about the powerful prayer life of God's sanctified saints. James 5:16b, "The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective." God hears the prayer of His people, as they are living a life that pleases God, and asking in faith for God to hear our prayers. James, then, gives us Elijah as an example of the righteous man that prayed. James 5:17-18, "17 Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. 18 Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops." Elijah is a model of how God hears His people when we pray. God heard Elijah not because he was so handsome, tall, smart, rich, or any other reason. Elijah was simply a righteous person that believed God would answer him in prayer. That is all that is needed for us too, for God to hear us in prayer.

How many people do we need to come together to have a successful prayer meeting? We would love to have the whole church family, but we would be wise to remember Jesus' words in Matthew 18:19-20, "19 Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. 20 For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."
